# LMC to host financial aid session Feb. 9

**BENTON TOWNSHIP** — Lake Michigan College will host a session Sunday, Feb. 9, to help students secure financial aid, the college announced.

College Goal Sunday will be 2-4 p.m. in the One Stop Student Services Center at the Napier Avenue Campus. The free event is open to

high school seniors and adults planning to attend college in the fall.

Students under 23 are encouraged to bring a parent or guardian.

Financial aid experts will help attendees complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid form, which is also required for many

scholarship programs.

Attendees should bring their 2013 income records. Dependent students will need their parents' income information.

Students should also bring: FAFSA pin number (if they have one), Social Security numbers (or their parents' numbers), driver's

license, 2013 W-2s and other income records, 2013 bank statements, business and investment mortgage information, farm records, and alien registration cards for non-U.S. citizens.
