Classes offered are:

■ **Symphonic Wind Ensemble:** Music ranging from traditional through contemporary styles is covered in this course. The class meets from 1:30-2:30 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays, Sept. 2-Dec. 11, in room F-125. Cost is \$25.

■ **String Ensemble:** The String Ensemble performs music of various periods in regular concerts each semester. The class meets from 1:30-2:30 p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays, Sept. 2-Dec. 11. Cost is \$25.

■ **Jazz Band:** The Jazz Band will practice and perform music in all styles of jazz and rock idioms. The instruction will include techniques of rehearsing stage band, playing of student arrangements and performance of jazz compositions, concert arrangements, and various rock idioms. The class meets from 4:10-6:20 p.m. Wednesdays, Sept. 3-Dec. 10, in room F-125. Cost is \$25.
