LMC women advance to regional final

The Lake Michigan College women's basketball team defeated Muskegon Community College 63-53 on Thursday night to advance to the regional championship game.

Sabrina Trujillo led the Red Hawks with 18 points and five assists. Lexi Firovich scored 15, and Nicole Decker added 13 points and six assists. Shalay Stevens had nine points, 17 rebounds and six steals.

LMC will face Kalamazoo Valley at 3 p.m. Saturday at Delta Community College for the title. KVCC won the two previous meetings between the teams by a

total of six points.
