BENTON HARBOR — In October, 18 members of the Lake Michigan College Mathletes team competed against 1,200 students from across the nation during the bi-annual Student Math League Competition.

The students completed 20 math problems in one hour during the competition, held by the American Mathematical Association of Two-Year Colleges.

The six top-ranking

LMC students were Michael Hettlinger, Rebecca Jacobs, Jonah Kubath, David Shane, Nicholas Spearitt and Matthew Starkey.

Shane's score was the highest ever attained by an LMC student and the sixth best in the Midwest region. Jacobs' score tied for 19th best in the region.
