

LMC sets open house, financial aid session

BENTON TOWNSHIP — Lake Michigan College is hosting a Spring Open House and financial aid workshop 11 a.m.-1 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 27, at the Napier Avenue campus, LMC announced.

Prospective students and their families can get free help completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. Students in Michigan who are graduating from high school in 2016 or are currently in college need to submit their application by March 1 to get the most assistance for college.

Guests are encouraged to first visit fafsa.ed.gov to create a FAFSA ID and pin number and bring 2015 federal tax return documents for themselves or their guardians if the student is a dependent.

Guests can tour LMC's campus and student housing facility, meet with professors, explore degree, certificate and transfer programs, and learn about intercollegiate athletics and honors programs.

Representatives from LMC's on-campus university partners, Siena Heights University and Western Michigan University-Southwest, will discuss transfer programs without leaving LMC's campus.

Campus tours will be at 11:15 a.m., 11:45 a.m., and 12:30 p.m. A presentation on Beckwith Hall, LMC's housing facility, will be at noon. A university transfer presentation will be at 12:30 p.m. LMC music major, Charles Esparza, will provide live musical entertainment.
