LMC men rally, win in OT over GRCC

BENTON TOWNSHIP — After trailing by as many as 15 points in the first half, the Lake Michigan College men's basketball team came back for a thrilling 80-71 overtime victory over Grand Rapids Community College on Wednesday.

"That was the key for us winning the game, getting the deficit down to five by halftime," said LMC men's coach Doug Schaffer.

Terry Davis had a game-high 28 points for LMC (9-3 MCCA West, 19-6). Ja'Mare Washington had 24 points and 14 rebounds for the Red Hawks.

Michael Bush had 19 points and 13 assists for LMC.

Grand Rapids falls to 2-11 in the conference and 9-14 overall.

The LMC women's basketball team lost to Grand Rapids 81-79, dropping its record to 10-3 in the MCCA Western Conference and 20-5 overall.
