LMC men nip Kellogg 79-76

BATTLE CREEK — Terry Davis had 24 points and Ja'mare Washington had 13 points and 10 rebounds as the Lake Michigan College men's basketball team edged Kellogg Community College 79-76 on Saturday.

"(It was a) hard-fought win on the road this afternoon," LMC coach Doug Schaffer said. "Mike Bush hit two free throws with seven seconds left to give us a three-point lead and Kellogg's Mafiaion Joyner's 3-point attempt at the buzzer was off the mark."

LMC improves to 11-3 in the MCCA Western Conference and 21-5 overall with the victory.

Joyner's game-high 30 points paced Kellogg (2-12, 5-19).

The LMC women's basketball team defeated Kellogg 77-63. Complete results were unavailable.

W. Michigan upends C. Michigan 92-85

KALAMAZOO, Mich. (AP) — Thomas Wilder scored 26 points as Western Michigan upended

Central Michigan 92-85 on Saturday.

Wilder was 10 of 16 from the field including a pair of 3-pointers. Tucker Haymond added 19 points and seven rebounds, Drake LaMont had 18 points and Bryce Moore chipped in 10 for the Broncos (11-16, 5-9 Mid-American Conference) who had a 39-28 rebounding edge over Central Michigan.

E. Michigan beats Toledo 91-85

YPSILANTI, Mich. (AP) — Brandon Nazione scored 21 points and Raven Lee hit critical free throws down the stretch to send Eastern Michigan to a 91-85 victory over Toledo on Saturday.

The Eagles (14-13, 6-8 Mid-American), who shot 77 percent in the first half and 68 percent overall, never trailed.

The Rockets (16-11, 7-7) rallied from a 19-point first-half deficit to cut EMU's lead to 78-77 with 2:28 left on Stuckey Mosley's 3-point play. The Eagles' Tim Bond hit a 3-pointer before Lee added six straight free throws to lead 87-83 with 30 seconds left.
