Russian ballet company to play LMC

BENTON TOWNSHIP — Lake Michigan College has accepted a \$2,500 Heart of Cook Foundation grant to offset the costs of bringing the Russian National Ballet to the Mendel Center on Jan. 20, for a performance of “Cinderella.”

The production costs

are about \$30,000, which the college will cover through corporate sponsorships, ticket sales and the grant.

“It’s a small grant, but it’s allowing us to bring in the Russian National Ballet,” Spielvogel said. “We do try and provide performing arts activities for our region, and this is one of the expenses we incur.
