Red Hawks swept by KVCC

BENTON TOWNSHIP — Lake Michigan College's softball team struggled offensively Wednesday, getting swept by Kalmazoo Valley Community College 6-0 and 2-1 in eight innings.

6-2 LMC 0-1 The Red Hawks (1-10 MCCAA, 1-16) mustered just five hits all afternoon and never led in either game.

"They were not strong in the box and when you have an error you lose," said LMC coach Melissa Grau.

LMC wasted a strong start in the second game from Dezray Watts, who pitched all eight innings and scatered seven hits.

Watts gave up a single to Kyla Nickrent to open the eighth inning, then hit Ashely Miller to put the go-ahead run at second base. Amber Forster brought Nickrent home with her second hit of the game, a single to center field.

"The bottom line is, yesterday (in a doubleheader against Ancilla College, Watts) just pitched 10 (innings)," Grau said. "So it wasn't her, it was just that they can hit. When you can hit and when you're dominant in the box you're going to find a way to get on."

That would be enough for Kalamazoo Valley pitcher Bailey Clements, who retired the last 16 batters she faced to get the comple game victory.

"She settled in just fine" said Kalamazoo Valley coach Sarah Thomas. "It took her a minute, but she brought it."

Mackenzie Orphanidis provided the only offensive spark for LMC, a solo home run to lead off the second inning. That was the only extra base hit on
