The **Twin City Players** will host its annual **Tiffany Awards**, which recognize the performances and achievements of its members and volunteers from the past season, at 6 p.m. Saturday on the **TCP Campus**, 600 W. Glenford Road, St. Joseph.

A catered dinner will be followed by the award ceremony and entertainment at 7:30 p.m. This year's "Old Tyme Hollywood" theme encourages guests to dress in old Hollywood attire.

TCP members and pass holders nominated candidates in 10 different categories, including leading actress, supporting actor and more from the season's six mainstage shows. A secret panel of judges selects each year's winners. Backstage and volunteer contributions also are recognized with various special awards.
