LMC men shoot well in win over Glen Oaks

CENTREVILLE — The Lake Michigan College men's basketball team used terrific 3-point shooting to cruise past Glen Oaks on Saturday for a road MCCA West division 93-63 win. The Red Hawks hit 15 3s in the game.

Seven different players hit 3s for LMC. Jake Shafer had the most 3s with four and 12 points overall.

Gavin Rasler led the Red Hawks with 15 points.

LMC (3-3 MCCA West, 6-11) jumped out to a 22-9 lead after one quarter and kept building the lead after that.

For Glen Oaks (0-6, 0-12), Stephen Matthews led the way with 26 points.

Morris leaving U-M for Central Michigan

ANN ARBOR (AP) — Shane Morris is leaving Michigan as a graduate transfer to use his final year of eligibility at Central Michigan.

The quarterback announced his decision Saturday on Twitter after posting two weeks ago that he was transferring.

Morris played sparingly

last season for Jim Harbaugh after redshirting in Harbaugh's first year as the Wolverines' coach. He played in 10 games, starting in two, over his first two years at Michigan under Brady Hoke.

He has completed 47 of 92 passes for 434 yards with five interceptions and no touchdown passes in his career.

Morris has a shot to play for the Chippewas, who started Cooper Rush for 37 games the previous three seasons.

WMU can't stop Perkins, Buffalo

BUFFALO, N.Y. (AP) — Nick Perkins scored 21 points and grabbed 10 rebounds to lead Buffalo in a 66-54 win over Western Michigan on Saturday.

It was the third double-double this season for Perkins who was 5 of 10 from the floor and 9 of 10 from the free throw line for the Bulls (9-10, 3-3 Mid-American).

Blake Hamilton added 15 points and 10 assists and Willie Conner had 12 points.

Seth Dugan led the Broncos (6-12, 2-4) with 18 points and 12 rebounds.
