LMC women's hoops falls to Lansing

LANSING – The Lake Michigan College women's basketball team outscored Lansing Community College 16-8 in the final quarter, but it was not enough to stop the Stars in a 62-61 loss on Saturday afternoon.

Hailey Maas scored a game-high 22 points. The Red Hawks (11-3 MC-CAA West, 19-6) fell behind by 11 points with three minutes remaining in the third quarter but were not able to close the gap.

Chastity Potter led Lansing (7-7, 13-11) with 20 points.

LMC men downed in OT by Lansing

LANSING – The Lake Michigan College men's basketball team fell to Lansing Community College 126-118 in overtime on Saturday.

Brian Harris led the Red Hawks (7-7 MC-CAA West, 10-15) with 25 points. Bryce Saxton scored 23 points and Jason Walter added a double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds.

Lansing Community College's JaQuaries Furlow scored a game-high 47 points added 12 rebounds (12-2 MCCA West, 19-5).

After scoring 62 points in the second half, the Red Hawks forced overtime, but the Stars outscored the Red Hawks 23-15 in the extra period to grab the win and avoid a home upset.

Haymond leads WMU to victory over EMU

KALAMAZOO (AP) — Tucker Haymond scored 26 points and grabbed 10 rebounds to lead Western Michigan to an 88-80 victory over Eastern Michigan on Saturday.

It was Haymond's second straight double-double for the Broncos (11-15, 7-7 Mid-American Conference), who have won four straight and five of their last six games.

Eastern Michigan (13-14, 5-9) has lost six in a row.

Haymond was 8 of 11 from the floor and made 10 of 11 free throws. Thomas Wilder added 14 points for Western Michigan, which shot 51 percent (28 of 55) from the floor and made 24 of 32 (75 percent) from the line.

Ray Lee scored a season-high 27 points to lead Eastern Michigan, which shot 58 percent from the field but made just 12 of 21 free throws. James Thompson IV and Willie Mangum IV added 13 points apiece.
